Preschool Tuition Plan

Registration and Tuition Fees

Registration Fee:

- includes books/learning materials, baby wipes, paper towels, Kleenex, and Clorox wipes
- is due in full with the enrollment application.
- is due annually and is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Weekly fee covers child's care from 6:45 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., breakfast, morning snack, lunch, and an afternoon snack.

Late Pickup Policy

If your child is picked up after 5:30, you will be charged \$10.00 the first 5 minutes (5:35) and \$3.00 each additional minute you are late. You will be considered late at 5:31, and fees are due at the time you pick up your child.

Payment Schedule

Weekly Payments – First two weeks are due in advance; thereafter your tuition is due on Monday of each week to avoid a \$20.00 late fee. Weekly payments must remain a week in advance to avoid a \$20.00 late fee.

Bi-Weekly Payments – Tuition must be paid every two weeks, but payment must be received in advance to avoid a \$30.00 late fee.

Monthly Payments – Monthly rates will vary from month-to-month depending on the number of Mondays in the month. Monthly payments are due on the first Monday of the month to avoid a \$50.00 late fee.

General Information

We do not prorate tuition fees, and no deductions are made on tuition fees for holidays, inclement weather, vacations, or absences. After your child has been enrolled for one full calendar year, a one-week vacation will be granted. The vacation week must be five (5) consecutive days.

NOTE: Delinquent weekly and bi-weekly accounts will be changed to a monthly payment plan.

Withdrawal Policy – A written notification is required one month in advance, and tuition is due for that entire month whether or not you choose to bring your child into the center.
